MARGRETHE ODGAARD ON THE DESIGN "From a distance, the Ripple Throw looks monotone, but at close range, an optic ripple pattern appears and changes according to its drape and movement. I wanted to create a throw that would feel like a second skin in a casual and elegant way. The airy structure is visually compelling, and I discovered that the air between the fibers form a heat-protective membrane. The result is a soft and warm throw that will keep your eyes intrigued because of its many nuances."

### DESCRIPTION

A soft cotton throw made using a unique weaving technique inspired from the fashion industry. Ripple is light and delicate, yet with a warm feel, framed by two-colored weaved borders.

### PRODUCTION PROCESS

Made using a traditional technique, a Leno-weave. The technique originates from the fashion industry and is used in clothes detailing. Each throw's weave is a mix between 2-3 colors of yarn, weaved together to give the throw its 3-dimensional ripple effect.
